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CURRICULUM

Classical School is an official Core Knowledge® school that provides a rich and academically rigorous curriculum. The school promotes content-centered education, cultural literacy, and the values of a democratic society. For the sake of academic excellence, greater fairness, and higher literacy, Core Knowledge provides a solid, specific, shared core curriculum to help children establish a strong academic foundation.

Students at Classical School are skill grouped for math and reading. Reading instruction begins in kindergarten and continues through third grade using the SRA Direct Instruction programs. Once students learn to read, instruction focuses on the further development of fluency skills through literary analysis, vocabulary development, and the introduction of more complex syntax. After third grade, students learn to further their language arts skills through a solid body of unabridged, classic literature. Grammar and writing are emphasized in all grades and content areas. Math instruction is delivered through the Saxon Math program. Mastery in all skills is emphasized. Most students at Classical complete algebra or geometry by the end of the eighth grade.

Students at Classical School also receive a solid common knowledge base of American and world history, geography, science, and the fine arts – including a solid base in art history and music history. Spanish language instruction is provided daily in grades kindergarten through eight. Students in grades K – 8 participate in physical education, art production, and music classes each week. Orchestra is available for students in grades 4 – 8 and band for students in grades 6 – 8.

Classical School began in the fall of 1999. We currently enroll about 490 students in grades kindergarten through eight.
